



Attention Pharmacy and Store Staff

Yes—we provide **EC** (also called Emergency Contraception, “morning-after” pills, or Plan B®)

For women and men ages 18 and older:

- EC (Plan B®) is available without a prescription (“over-the-counter”) from the pharmacy counter with government issued ID.

For women under 18 or with no ID:

- Our pharmacy offers EC to women under 18 and those without ID who come in **with a prescription** from their doctor or clinic.
- Our pharmacy does/ does not have a specially trained pharmacist to provide EC for teens and women without ID who come in **without a prescription**.

For women on MassHealth:

- MassHealth will only cover EC with a prescription from a healthcare provider or specially trained pharmacist.
